Dear Tribal Leader:

I am writing to provide an update on our consultation on the Indian Health Service (IHS) Contract Support Costs (CSC) policy. Our goal is to update and implement a new policy in 2016. To accomplish this goal, the IHS CSC Workgroup has met several times over the past several months and completed their work in drafting a revised policy. Next week, IHS will send out a copy of the revised policy for your review and comment for 60-days.
