Priority: Ending the Opioid Epidemic

- Surgeon General Advisory on Naloxone
- Indian Health Manual <u>Chapter 35: Prescribing and Dispensing Naloxone to First Responders</u>
- Large-scale naloxone distribution effort which began in partnership with the Bureau of Indian Affairs in December 2015
- HHS announced that Dr. Brett Giroir will be responsible for coordinating

efforts across HHS to fight America's opioid crisis.

 On March 14, our Chief Medical Officer, Dr. Michael Toedt, testified during the Senate Indian Affairs Committee oversight hearing on "Opioids in Indian Country: Beyond the Crisis to Healing the Community".

IHS budget

- The fiscal year 2018 Omnibus provides federal appropriations through the end of September.
- The spending bill includes \$5.5 billion for the IHS, which is an increase of \$498 million.

 Congress has also enacted legislation to provide \$150 million for each of fiscal years 2018 and 2019 for the Special Diabetes Program for Indians

(SDPI).
