2.2.1 Required Resources

- Kernel v8.0 patch 1018 (XU*8.0*1018) or later
- FileMan v22.0 patch 1018 (DI*22.0*1018) or later
- MU Performance Reports v1.0 through patch 10 (apcm0100.10k)

2.3 Before You Begin: Installation Issues

1. Make a copy of this distribution for offline storage.
2. Print all notes/readme files.
3. Create a printed audit trail in case there are any problems with the installation.

To capture terminal output during the installation, use an auxport printer attached to the terminal on which the installation is being performed.

3.0 Installation Instructions

Note: This installation is a KIDS install. For any questions on how to do a KIDS installation, please contact your Area Office information systems support personnel.

In all Unique Client Identifiers (UCIs) running the Promoting Interoperability Performance Reports (APCM):

1. Ensure that users are unable to use the application for the duration of this installation.
2. Save all routines (^%RO (CACHE) in the APCM* namespace for use in returning to the prior existing version, if needed.

Note: If no problems are noted with the new installation, remove saved routines from your system seven to ten days after this install.

3. Install **apcm0200.k**. This is the KIDS file for the Promoting Interoperability Performance Reports (APCM):
 - a. Load the distribution into KIDS using **Option 1** on the **KIDS Installation** menu. The distribution was released in a file named **apcm0200.k**.
 - b. Verify the load using **Option 2** on the **KIDS Installation** menu.
 - c. Consider using **Options 3** and **4** on the **KIDS Installation** menu to print and compare the Transport global.
 - d. Install the distribution using **Option 6** on the **Installation** menu.
 - e. To see results, use the **KIDS Install File Print** option to view/print the IHS MU PERFORMANCE REPORTS V2.0 entry.

Note: For assistance with a KIDS install, call the Area Office support personnel.

4. After the install completes, assign security keys, as appropriate, using Table 3-1.

Table 3-1: Assigning security keys

Name	Descriptive Name	Description
APCMZ PATIENT LISTS	MU Reports Patient Lists	This key allows the holder to obtain patient lists. The patient lists contain sensitive patient/clinical information. This key should be given <i>only</i> to those users who have a need for such information.
