## 1.0 Release Notes

This VA utility will be used by future EHR applications. Simply install it on your system. There is no need to place the few menu options on any user's menu. The utility is accessed primarily by APIs called by other packages.

This utility uses the LEX namespace but also includes 2 GMPT and 4 ICPT routines. GMPT is the old namespace for Lexicon and these routines are still called by other VA applications. The ICPT routines are called by Lexicon and are required until such time as the IHS ACPT and VA ICPT packages are merged.

### 2.0 Installation Notes

Prefix: LEX

Current Version: 2.0

**Warning**: Read entire notes file prior to attempting any installation.

#### 2.1 General Information

- Make a copy of this distribution for offline storage.
- Print all notes/readme files.
- It is recommended that the terminal output during the installation be captured using an auxport printer attached to the terminal at which you are performing the software installation. This will insure a printed audit trail if any problems should arise.
- This VA utility will be used by future EHR applications. All you need to do is install it on your system. There is no need to place the few menu options on any user's menu. The utility is accessed primarily by APIs called by other packages.
- This utility uses the LEX namespace but also includes 2 GMPT and 4 ICPT routines. GMPT is the old namespace for Lexicon and these routines are still called by other VA applications. The ICPT routines are called by Lexicon and are required until such time as the IHS ACPT and VA ICPT packages are merged.

- lex\_0200.g—^LEX global ~ 140 MB (VA sends only the ^LEXT global in the KIDS file)

#### 2.3 Requirements

Kernel	v8.0 or later
FileMan	v22

Package	Minimum Version
Cache	v4.1 or later
ACPT	v2003 patch 2 must be installed
AUPN	v99.1 patch 11 must be installed
AUT	v98.1 patch 14 must be installed

### 3.0 Installation Instructions

In all namespaces to run EHR (Cache required):

- 1. If you already have the Lexicon Utility installed, save your current ^LEX global to disk. Then remove the ^LEX global from your Cache database.
- 2. Unzip the global file lex\_0200.g.gz, if not already unzipped. Restore the ^LEX global from the lex\_0200.g file. This was saved using Cache format.
- 3. Under KIDS, load then install lex\_0200.k. Answer YES to all "Want to continue" questions. Answer NO to the other questions.
- 4. If you have the ^GMP or ^GMPT globals, you can delete them now.
- 5. Give yourself the LEXZMENU key so you can access the LEX MGT MENU (optional).
- 6. Now the Lexicon Utility is ready to be called by EHR applications.
