


Summary

- Influenza activity is increasing, with certain regions (Nashville) experiencing sharp increases.
- Influenza vaccine coverage is increasing, but many patients remain unvaccinated.

All IHS Areas Influenza-Like Illness (ILI) for All Surveillance Years Percentage of Visits for ILI per week 01/04/09 to 12/08/12






