Dear Tribal Leader:

On October 4, 2018, I wrote to you announcing a new automated tool for electronically submitting Catastrophic Health Emergency Fund (CHEF) requests.

As the Tribal Leader letter mentioned, the Indian Health Service (IHS) held four 3-hour training sessions for the target audience of PRC staff and managers. The CHEF Online Tool (TOOL) training provided a live demonstration of the TOOL, followed by a question and answer session. The IHS Director's Workgroup on Improving Purchased/Referred Care recommended that additional training be provided for Information Technology (IT) staff prior to implementing the TOOL.

The new implementation date for the TOOL is Wednesday, May 1, 2019.

I would like to encourage you to widely share the below training dates. The target audience for these sessions is IT staff and managers responsible for coordinating IT activities. The 1-hour training will provide information on TOOL system requirements via Adobe Connect, followed by a question and answer session.
