## Dear Arizona Tribal Leaders:

I am writing to initiate Tribal Consultation in follow-up to the completion of our multi-year feasibility study on designating the State of Arizona as a Purchased/Referred Care Delivery Area (PRCDA).

The IHS first initiated Tribal Consultation on this topic on November 20, 2018, when we sought your recommendations and guidance on the implications of establishing a PRCDA for the entire State of Arizona. A subsequent face-to-face Tribal Consultation was convened during the Phoenix Area Tribal Budget Formulation Meeting on November 27, 2018, followed by a conference call to Arizona Tribal Leaders on December 19, 2018.

Two virtual Tribal Consultation sessions on the feasibility study results will be provided as follows:
