Measles

Measles can cause serious health issues, especially in children younger than 5 years old.

SIGNS AND SYMPTOMS

 7-14 days after exposure: high fever, cough, runny nose, red and watery eyes.



 3-5 days after the first symptoms begin: rash, usually on the face and down the body.



 Common complications are ear infections and diarrhea.



 Less frequently, severe complications like pneumonia and encephalitis can occur.



Protect against measles with the measles, mumps, and rubella (MMR) vaccine, it is safe and effective. Talk to a health care provider about the MMR vaccine.
