Protect your baby, get tested for syphilis.

Syphilis is a sexually transmitted infection that can pass from mother to baby. If not treated it can:

- Make babies very sick.
- Cause babies to have ongoing health issues.
- Some cases can be fatal.



Syphilis can be cured.

Talk to your doctor about how often you should be tested. It is best to get tested three times during your pregnancy.

If drugs or alcohol are a concern, we welcome you to our facilities for prenatal care.
