
## **ALERT on TIANEPTINE**

 Tianeptine, sold under the brand names Stablon, Tatinol, and Coaxil among others, is an atypical tricyclic antidepressant which is used mainly in the treatment of major depressive disorder, although it may also be used to treat anxiety, asthma, and irritable bowel syndrome.



- Tianeptine is **NOT** approved by the Food and Drug Administration (FDA).
- Clinical effects of tianeptine abuse and withdrawal can be like opioid addiction, toxicity and withdrawal.
- The FDA continues to receive reports of consumers who have suffered seizures, loss of consciousness or other adverse health events after ingesting this product. The street name for tianeptine is "gas station heroin."
