**Immediate Use Compounding Evaluation**

**Purpose:** Participants will acquire knowledge of Immediate Use IV compounding practices for improved patient safety and prevent infection/contamination.

**Competency Statement:** Participants will demonstrate the necessary skills for immediate use compounding annually.

Gathers drug/supplies needed prior to start of compounding.		
Counter was cleaned appropriately.		
Hand hygiene was done correctly.		
Ensure syringes, needles, and tubing remain in their individual packaging and are only opened in the dedicated medication preparation area.		
Understands the preparation involves not more than 3 different sterile products.		
Gloves are donned and appropriate disinfection has been completed including friction at critical sites using sterile 70% IPA.		
Affixes needles to syringes and does not expose critical sites (needle hub, plunger, ports, etc.) to touch contamination.		
Disposes of sharps and waste according to institutional policy.		
Medication is compounded using aseptic technique with no interruptions.		
Any opened single-dose containers must be disposed of and not used for more than one patient.		
The final product is correctly labeled.		
Understands that the administration of the prepared compound must be used within 4 hours following the start of the preparation. If administration has not begun within 4 hours from the start of the preparation, it must be disposed of.
