The following equipment list contains items that are needed in an eye clinic. The optometrist/ophthalmologist at the location will need to determine which equipment from the list, and any additional equipment, is required at that facility and the quantity of each required item. The type and quantity should be based on the type of eye care program that will be carried out at the facility. Generic or brand names may be given. Discussions with the Service Unit or Indian Health Service Area biomedical officer is recommended. This list is complete for a one-lane examining room. The equipment needs for a facility with more than one eye lane will need to be appropriately adjusted. The quantity of each item is listed in parenthesis.
