Preparing the Grant Application



Application Materials

- On the <u>P4 Grant Resources website</u>
 - Instructions for how to access P4 Application Kit
 - FY25 Continuation Application Kickoff Webinar Recording
- In <u>GrantSolutions</u>
 - Application Kit
 - Forms SF-424 and 424A
 - Continuation Application Project Narrative
- Grantee Prepared/Acquired
 - Budget Narrative
 - Indirect Cost Rate Agreement (if applicable)
 - Resume for Key Personnel (optional recipient would only need to send these if there are new personnel)
 - Key Contacts Form (optional same situation as the Resumes)
 - Other (optional in case the recipient has anything else they want considered)



Tips for Using the P4 Project Narrative

- Ensure the Project Narrative is in PDF format.
- Download (Save) a copy of the Project Narrative template to your computer.
- Ensure that all contributors are using Adobe Reader or Pro software to complete.
- Save the completed document do not print and/or scan.
- Proofread to ensure all fields are completed and to minimize grammatical/spelling errors.

The template is provided for submitting the required information and to prepare a successful (and complete) Project Narrative.

Submitting Your Application in GrantSolutions

- 1. Log into GrantSolutions.
- 2. Click on "Apply for Non-Competing Award;" this link will be available under "My Grants List."
- 3. Complete online forms and upload file attachments for each enclosure in the application kit.
- 4. After completing all the forms, click on "Verify Submission" to submit the application to IHS.
- 5. Click on "Final Submission."
- 6. Click on "OK" upon the prompt "Are you sure you want to submit application?"
- 7. You cannot alter any information once it is submitted.

Review of Applications



Application Screening

- All applications will be screened for adherence to the instructions from the DGM and DDTP, including submission of all required documents.
- Applicants who do not submit all required documents in the correct format may be contacted to provide the proper documentation before their application can be reviewed.
 - This may result in a delayed NoA and/or Special Grant Conditions on their NoA issuing funds for 2025.



Application Review

Grant applications that pass screening will be reviewed by the Program Officer, or their designee, based on the following:

- Compliance with the Terms and Conditions outlined in the FY24 NoA
- Satisfactory business (fiscal) review of the FY25 application
- Satisfactory programmatic review of the FY25 application, including:
 - Completeness of information from the Project Narrative template
 - Documented plan for continued work and evaluation in FY25



Application Review (cont'd)

- Grantees with applications that are approved with restrictions will have Special Grant Condition(s) placed on their FY25 Notice of Award.
- Special Grant Conditions are notes added onto the NoA that describe missing documentation or revisions needed.
- Some Special Grant Conditions may also place funding restrictions until specified documents or revisions are submitted and approved.
