 Vision: Healthy communities and quality health care systems through strong partnerships and culturally responsive practices creating: ONE INDIAN HEALTH SERVICE.

One IHS

Everyone working towards the same mission and every employee belonging to something bigger than themselves. Together we learn, grow, share our expertise, identify risks, collaboratively work through failures, and share best practices and learnings. We apply the central principles of a High Reliability Organization (HRO): (1) practice sensitivity to operations, (2) preoccupation with failure, (3) reluctance to simplify, (4) commitment to resilience, and (5) deference to expertise. We are stronger together than siloed.


